Subject: Release of Admit Card for Common University Entrance Test [CUET (PG) – 2024]

The National Testing Agency (NTA) will be conducting Common University Entrance Test [CUET (PG) – 2024] for admission to Post Graduate Courses for the academic session 2024-25 between 11th March to 28th March 2024 in the computer-based mode.

Admit Card of candidates appearing for the examination scheduled to be held on 11th March 2024, are hosted on https://pgcuet.samarth.ac.in/.

Admit Card for the candidates whose examinations are scheduled on later dates beyond 11th March 2024 will also be updated and released subsequently.

Candidates can download their Admit Card from the said website using their Application Form Number and Date of Birth. Candidates are also advised to read the instructions contained therein carefully.

Candidates are advised to note the following:

- The Admit Card is issued provisionally to the candidates, subject to the fulfilment of the eligibility conditions.
- Admit Card will not be sent by post.
- Candidate should not mutilate the Admit Card or change any entry made therein.
- Issue of Admit Card, however, shall not necessarily mean acceptance of eligibility which shall be further scrutinized at subsequent stages of the admission process.
- Candidates are advised to preserve a copy of their Admit Card in good condition for future reference.
